# Booking info

Tickets are available online and in person, both at the event and in a temporary pop-up box office. However, we highly recommend booking online as events are expected to sell-out and there is no separate allocation for in-person box office sales, nor is there a difference in price between online or in person. All prices shown are inclusive of booking engine fees unless stated otherwise. Free events require a pre-booked ticket, unless event has 'drop by' in its listing.

During the festival there will be a box office at the Lodge Grounds, open between 10.00AM and 10.00PM daily (4th - 13th August).

Tickets are sent as an e-ticket, which can be presented on your mobile device at the door. Alternatively, print the e-ticket at home and bring it with you.

Programme details are correct at the time of going to press. Fringe By The Sea reserves the right to alter or cancel events. Tickets are non-refundable unless an event is cancelled. Please check the festival website and social media feeds for all the latest news and updates.

Accessibility: All venues at Fringe By The Sea are wheelchair accessible. Please let a member of stewarding team know of your needs on arrival. If you have a carer requiring a ticket, please contact info@fringebythesea.com at least 24 hours in advance of your show to make arrangements or a steward upon arrival at the event if booking less than 24 hours before the event. An accessible drop off point is located on the junction of St Baldred's Road and Lady Jane Road. Limited accessible seating is available in each venue. This is allocated on a first come, first serve basis. Please email info@fringebythesea.com in advance to reserve a space.

Concession tickets: Where applicable, concession tickets are available for children. Babes in arms go free.

Age restrictions: Please take note of age suitability of events, where stated. Fringe By The Sea is family friendly and we encourage kids to come along and enjoy many of our gigs. Evening events require U16s to be accompanied by an adult.

Venues: The festival venue at the Lodge Grounds is open from 10AM to 11PM daily. As our festival is outdoors, it can get chilly in the evenings and our venues are sited on uneven ground, please dress appropriately. No smoking or vaping inside our venues.

Food & Drink: As the venues are licenced premise operations, alcohol is not allowed to be brought onto the festival site. Food is available to purchase at our Street Food hub. Hot and cold beverages and alcohol drinks will be available to purchase on site.

Latecomers: Events start punctually. Members of the audience may not be permitted entry after the beginning of events.

Entry: Please follow all signage for queuing, entering and exiting our venues. There may be a different point of entry from exit at each venue. Our staff will direct you to seats, where relevant. Please follow their instruction.

Lost property: Lost property will be stored at the Box Offices for the festival duration and at our office afterwards. Any items not collected within a fortnight of the festival from The Lighthouse will be disposed of. Lost children will be taken to our Crew Hut (behind Box Office).

Dogs: Well behaved dogs on leads are welcome on site and in venues, except standing gigs in the Big Top.

Well, the wait is over and with a bumper programme of more than 225 events, we have the key ingredients for a fabulous 15th edition of East Lothian's favourite festival. Bring. It. On.

We return to the wonderful Lodge Grounds once again. With the free-to-access North Berwick Trust Hub the place to be for tasty food and drink, catching cracking local talent on the awesome Lighthouse Live stage or perusing beautiful arts and crafts at Coulters Makers Market. We aim to have something for everyone, regardless of pocket size.

Our 2023 Weaving Wonder theme sees community initiatives come to life in many forms, including a guite literal manifestation, with the Wool School leading the charge to knit festival bunting!

Wonder is well and truly woven throughout the 10 days in our music, comedy, literature, children's and masterclass billings.

Our music line-up is an eclectic mix from smash-hit international superstars to brilliant East Lothian-based performers. We have sand dunes, salty air and dance beats aplenty as Groove Armada return to North Berwick - who can forget their epic 2019 spiegeltent show??? - to get the party started on opening night and after the success of last year's Saturday headliner, we've gone west again with gallus Glasgow band *Travis* topping the bill on the first weekend.

Get ready to dress up for Disco Day with Sister Sledge on the second Friday, while Stornoway sensations Peat & Diesel will have the big top bouncing the night after. Our festival will close with another epic orchestral show when the International Film Orchestra perform The Spectacular Music of Harry Potter.

Our ever-popular comedy shows are expanding with Dara Ó Briain, Dylan Moran and Susie McCabe just a few of the side-splitters coming to Scotland especially for Fringe By The Sea.

Our Lodge Tent comes with an increased capacity, meaning more people can come and hear inspiring talks from authors. environmentalists, explorers and others with a fascinating story to tell. The fearless ocean-faring record-setter Sir Robin Knox-Johnston, presented by McInroy & Wood, wildlife photographer and reigning Strictly champion Hamza Yassin, Great British Sewing Bee and Savile Row tailor Patrick Grant and East Lothian-born author William Dalrymple are just a few set to pack out the tents this year.

Our children's programme too is expanding, and we'll be seeing the likes of Dick & Dom join festival regulars Artie's Singing Kettle and Mr Boom. Of course, seeing our youngsters on stage is a huge part of Fringe By The Sea, and we're super excited to see so many shows featuring local talent on the programme.

We're indebted to SSE Renewables for the support of our Green Team, led by Caledonian Horticulture. Last year we put in place the gold standard of waste management processes, and this year we'll be showcasing in the festival hub exactly how we do it. Be sure to pay the Envirozone a visit to learn more about our environmental efforts and so much more.



# Bioblitz By The Sea

As part of Fringe By The Sea 2023, Scottish Seabird Centre is excited to be teaming up with scientists and nature organisations from around Scotland to deliver Bioblitz By The Sea, an action-packed celebration of marine and coastal wildlife.

We will work together in a race against the clock to discover and record as many animals and plants as possible, and we need your help! Come and join us for stalls, sessions, and self-led activities that will help you to discover and protect our amazing marine environment. Look around our bioblitz 'lab' and hear from experts about how collecting data can help to protect wildlife and wild places. Whether you're new to nature or already wildlife nerds like us, there will be something for everyone.
